We are called **INKuLtur**.

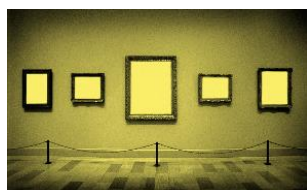


We are a network of people in Eastern Europe and Germany.



We want to help people with disabilities get better access to art and culture.

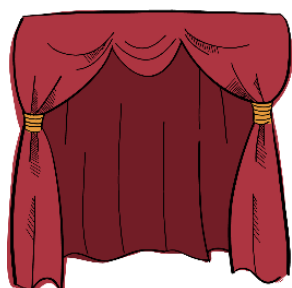
For example,

- making training videos



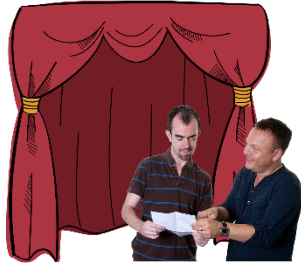
- working with others

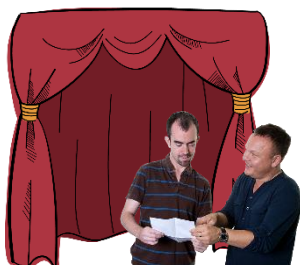

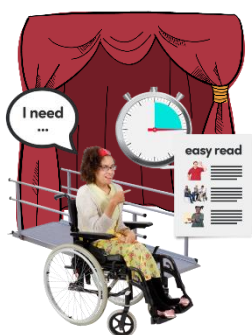
Video course
